To many, a pop tab is just a piece of aluminum with one purpose - to open a can. But for the elementary students at Park Falls Elementary School, they know how beneficial these tabs are for the families staying at the Ronald McDonald House in Marshfield. This home-away-from-home welcomes families of children who are being hospitalized or are receiving outpatient treatment at Ministry Saint Joseph's Children's Hospital or Marshfield Clinic.

For more than two years, 304 students in grades K-5 collected 963 pounds of pop tabs and then sold the tabs to a local recycling plant, earning \$501.

Funds received from the recycling of tabs or donations made by groups recycling their tabs in their local communities are a significant source of annual revenue that is applied to the operating expenses of the House.

"The students understand when they collect tabs they are helping others, and these are valuable life lessons we are trying to instill in our kids," said Daren Patterson, a guidance counselor at Park Falls Elementary. "Our objective was to have the students recognize the importance of understanding how they can give back and to make the world a better place, and this program really helped students clearly understand the importance of this during the hospitalization of a loved one."

Since many of the community members from the Park Falls area have used the House in the past, the students were very inspired and motivated to collect tabs, knowing how important it was for these families staying at the home. Kayla Herbst, 10, of Park Falls, was one of the students who collected the tabs and also made a special visit to the House to personally drop off the check on June 24. She is well aware of the impor-

tance of this House, since she and her twin sister, Korrie, were born 6 weeks premature and in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit at Ministry Saint Joseph's Children's Hospital for 3 weeks. As a result of the accommodations offered at the House, her parents were able to remain close to the girls during their entire hospitalization.

"Thanks to generous school children, families, businesses, clubs and churches, millions of aluminum tabs have been donated in the 18 years since the program began, generating a total of about \$73,000 in pop tab revenue for the House," said Sandra Zygarlicke, Ronald McDonald House director.

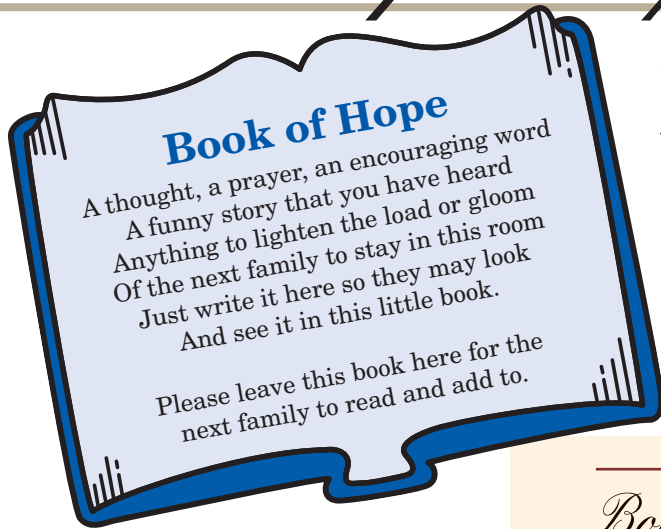
Since the inception of the house in 1983, more than 8,200 families from 47 Wisconsin counties, 6 states and 3 foreign countries have called the House their home.

Today, there are Ronald McDonald Houses worldwide, with three in Wisconsin. In September, the 300th House will open in St. Louis, Missouri.

fast. Andrew counted over 200 beats per minute. I told him that we needed to go to the Emergency Room right then.

By the time we got to the hospital, which is only five minutes away from the school, Ian's heart rate was 315 beats per minute. They hooked him up to all kinds of machinery. I was OK with seeing this, but as soon as they were about to give him an IV and draw blood, I had to leave. I can't stand to see my baby cry. Andrew stayed in the room with him while I stepped out.

June 5, 2010

Hello. My name is Rebecca, and my son's name is Ian. Our stay here was short. I'm glad we were here only three days. Ian was transported by ambulance from Tomahawk Medical Center to Saint Joseph's Children's Hospital on Friday, June 4, because of a rapid heart rate. When we got down here, Ian was diagnosed with Wolff-Parkinsons-White syndrome. It's also known as SVT. Ian was born with an extra valve in his heart. He will now be on medication for the next year, at least. His doctor would like to do surgery to remove the extra valve, but he won't be able to do the surgery until Ian is at least 50 pounds or three years old. We probably wouldn't have ever known about his heart condition if his heart rate had not risen when it did.

Our day started off like any normal day. Ian woke up at 7:30 AM, and we got him bathed and ready for the day. That morning we had to go to my nephew's Kindergarten graduation. We just sat down, and Ian's daddy Andrew started feeding him. After a few ounces, he sat Ian up to burp him. When he put his hand on Ian's chest, he said Ian's heart was beating way too
