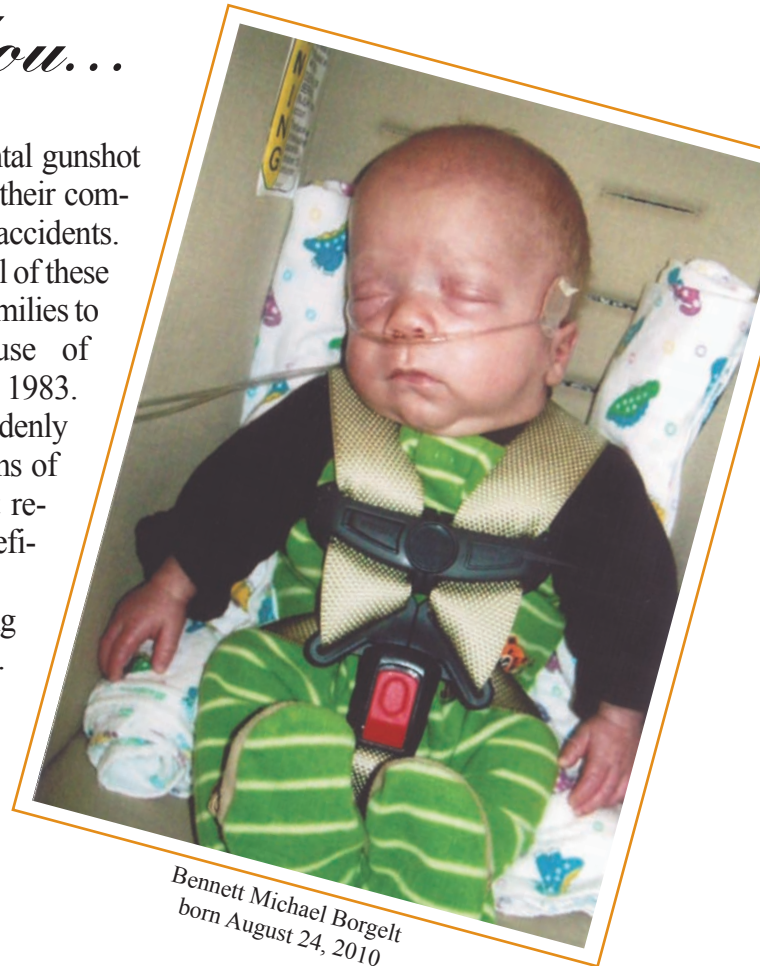

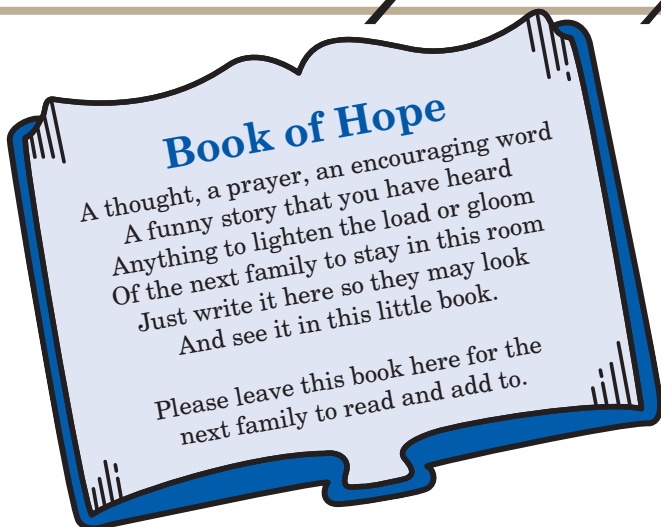

# Book of Hope



The impact of your support is revealed in the words of our guest families who have given their permission to share their stories.

July 13, 2010

Six long weeks after my 15-year old son was the accidental victim of a gunshot wound to the head, we will be leaving for a short stay in a rehabilitation unit nearer our home in Michigan. This is the third time since 1989 that I have had the good fortune of staying near my children, thanks to the Ronald McDonald House, with two preemies and now our son. Without this "home" our visits would have been very limited due to the travel distance and expense of hotels for lengthy stays. Thanks to Ministry Saint Joseph's Children's Hospital, I have 3 living, breathing, healthy children.

Our son was given a 10% chance of surviving with an unknown quality of life ahead. As a nurse I have often talked to my children about what they would want their quality of life to be. Our son said he wanted to be able to ride his 4 wheeler and dirt bike, drive a car when he was 16 and live an independent life – to be happy.

With his injuries to his face, which were traumatic, the doctors were unable to determine if he had a tongue – his sinus cavity was referred to as "potato chips" and half of his upper and lower jaw was missing. TJ wanted to be an organ donor, and after given his pre-surgical news, that was my first response.

However, it took over three hours to get TJ from our home to our

local Emergency Department to be flown here. They could not intubate him, and that entire time he breathed on his own. As a nurse I have never witnessed an adult or child breathe that long on their own with no airway – or rather such a grossly impeded airway. Knowing he fought that hard to be here – the right choice was surgery.

Six weeks later my son is walking and talking, crying, laughing, loving life – loving us. He has a feeding tube and a tracheotomy – both of which are temporary. His left temporal lobe was removed but he is 100% still the same T.J.

We will be back in September to have his skull bone put back in and his eyes and sinuses surgically repaired. We will then be back after Christmas to have his jaws repaired and permanent teeth implanted.

So many ups and downs. So many good days and bad days. Sandra and the staff were my lifelines when my husband, mother or college-aged daughters could not be here. All of our stories are different- yet all the same. We are here because of our children. I pray that your journey here is short and your outcome is happy. Be strong, but remember it is ok to cry, to vent, and to be angry. Do not bottle up your emotions – it is ok to let them out. It's the only way we can remain fierce, determined, and strong for our children when we are here loving them, watching them and making life-changing medical decisions.

If you are here by yourself – you are not alone. I am daily thinking of the families here and praying for them and celebrating when they go home together. You are all in my heart, my thoughts and prayers.

When first seen by the doctors, she was given a 50/50 chance of living.

We lived in Stevens Point at the time but wanted to remain close to our daughter during those first hours. That is where you folks came in to play. Even though we had the financial means to stay elsewhere, you opened your doors to us and gave us a place to stay that first night without asking for anything from us in return.

Mattison is now seven and healthy. She is in the first grade. She enjoys school, loves to read & sing, and is active in her local Daisy troop.

We always wanted to find a way to try and give something back for the hospitality that you had shown to us during our short stay. We would occasionally donate our extra change in the drive thru, but it hardly seemed like enough. We always felt like we should do more, but never got around to doing it.

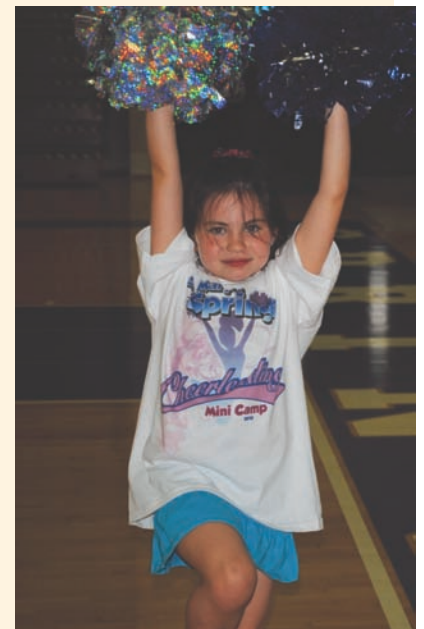
Leave it to Matti ...

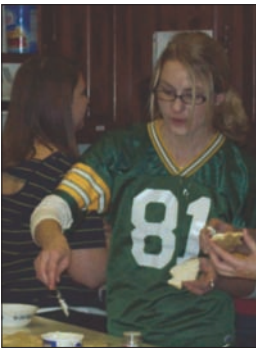
