

### RONALD McDONALD HOUSE® PROGRAM IMPACT

### Ronald McDonald House Benefits and Impact



In a survey of **250 families**, researchers found that children and their parents, who stayed at a Ronald McDonald House, had a better **perceived quality of life** than expected for children with chronic diseases.<sup>1</sup>

27% of parents experienced post-traumatic stress symptoms several months after their child's discharge<sup>3</sup> from a hospital stay, but Ronald McDonald Houses help their guests strengthen coping abilities by keeping families together.<sup>4</sup>





Ronald McDonald Houses provide spaces to play. Playing with other children experiencing similar situations can help these children cope with trauma.6

The Ronald McDonald Houses' proximity to hospitals

provides important benefits for children and their caregivers, such as improved psychological well-being and better perceptions of their child's recovery.<sup>2</sup>





Parents whose children have longer hospital stays benefit from **higher quality sleep** at a Ronald McDonald House compared to parents who slept at their child's hospital bedside <sup>5</sup>

Ronald McDonald Houses can provide an **alternative** for patients who need to remain close to the hospital for extended periods but do not require active daily medical care.<sup>7</sup>

### Volunteering Brings Many Benefits!

Volunteering has long been valued as part of a common ethic among folks in the United States. Volunteering can be formal-as in devoting time at a favorite non-profit charity each week like the Ronald McDonald House----OR informal, in the shape of doing a favor for friends or neighbors. While your volunteer activities are performed with the intention of helping others, there is also evidence that those who give of themselves also receive!

Research has established a connection between volunteering and health:

- those who volunteer have lower mortality rates
- those who volunteer have greater functional ability
- those who volunteer have lower rates of depression later in life than those who do not volunteer

Comparisons of the health benefits of volunteering for different age groups have also shown that older volunteers are the most likely to receive greater benefits from volunteering, whether because you are more likely to face higher incidence of illness or because volunteering provides you with physical and social activity and a sense of purpose at a time when your roles are changing.

Volunteers who devote a "considerable" amount of time to volunteer activities (about 100 hours per year) are most likely to exhibit positive health outcomes.

In its most recent annual report, the Corporation for National and Community Service shows WISCONSIN volunteerism ranks FIFTH among the 50 states and Washington, DC. WISCONSIN has an average volunteer rate of 35.1 percent of its residents, with approximately 1.6 million volunteers serving approximately 164 million total hours per year. (Our volunteers donated 750+ of those hours last year).

Registration will take place at the Lions Park Pavilion across from the Prentice High School from 10:00-10:30am.


