The Ronald McDonald House is a warm smile from a friendly volunteer, a home-cooked meal after a busy day at the hospital, a restful night’s sleep in a caring environment, and families helping each other through one of the toughest times in their lives.

Costly medical bills, siblings back home, and keeping up with their jobs are challenges that can push families to the breaking point. Lengths of stay can vary from one night for an out-patient surgery to many months for parents of a preemie baby. Although there is a nominal request of \$5.00 per night, many families are unable to pay due to the financial burden they are facing.

In 2015, our House families used our “home away from home” for 2,750 bed nights. Four families from OBGYN used 55 bed nights, 3 families with children in the Peds Oncology Unit used 21 bed nights, 28 families with an outpatient surgery used 47 bed nights, 64 families with children in Pediatrics used 245 bed nights, and 59 families with children in Peds Intensive Care used 356 bed nights. Finally, 47% of our families, or 127 families with babies in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, used 2,026 bed nights.

With so many families in need of your support, it is heartwarming to know that a caring community is there to guarantee that the Ronald McDonald House will be here for those families who depend on us during one of life’s most stressful and challenging times!

What a Blessing the House was!

I was recently reading your fall 2015 RMHC of Marshfield newsletter that my mom gave to me. She receives it because she & my dad have been donors for, well, over 19 years now, ever since our family needed the Ronald McDonald House. I read with much interest the stories of the now-healthy children whose families utilized the RMH services in the past. I felt compelled to share our little story and say a very heart-felt thank you.

In early 1997, our 9-month-old daughter, Emma, was diagnosed with Autoimmune Neutropenia, a fancy term meaning that her body wasn't producing enough white blood cells to fight normal infection on its own. While we were extremely relieved that it wasn't leukemia (which is what they at first thought), the result was still lots of time at Ministry Saint Joseph's Children's Hospital in isolation receiving IV antibiotics to help her body fight infection until her white blood cell counts would recover enough to be sent home. During these repeated trips to Marshfield, I stayed in her room with her; however, my husband (Emma's daddy) & my mom (Emma's grandma) stayed across the street at the RMH. What a blessing it was for all of us. As was predicted and hoped for, after a few years Emma's body "grew out of" the illness and life went on as Emma lived a very normal and healthy childhood. In fact, the blessing is that because she was a baby/toddler at the time, Emma doesn't even remember at all how very sick she was all those times.

This year, Emma will turn 20 years old and is in college.

Attached are two photos. The first is a photo that was taken of Emma and me after Emma had just woken up from a bone marrow aspiration procedure. (Sorry the quality isn't the best as it was taken a long time ago). The second is the beautiful young woman that Emma is today.

A Circle of Love

We use the term “come full circle” and sometimes don’t really stop to put it into perspective. Raymond Yunk has truly been a testament to the term.

Raymond is a 15 year old from Park Falls, WI. His parents are Randy and Heidi Yunk. Raymond is a typical teenager with a passion for hunting, fishing, and snowmobiling. On February 16, 2016, Raymond was involved in a tragic snowmobile accident in which he and another snowmobile collided head on. Raymond was taken to Flambeau Hospital in Park Falls and then flown to Ministry Saint Joseph’s Children’s Hospital in Marshfield where he was admitted to the Pediatric Intensive Care Unit. His parents drove down from Park Falls that night and arrived at the hospital at 1:00 am. Raymond was in the hospital for 13 days. He sustained injuries primarily to the face and underwent surgery to repair breaks to nose, jaw, and orbital plate. Following his stay, Raymond was released on March 1.

The beauty of this story lies in the fact that during the 2010 school year, Chequamegon Elementary School in Park Falls launched a huge campaign to collect the most poundage of aluminum can tabs for the Ronald McDonald House in Marshfield. To make the challenge more fun, the individual grades competed against each other for the most pounds each week. Raymond took this challenge very seriously. He commissioned grandparents, parents, and aunts and uncles from all over the state to save their can tabs. He even put receptacles in businesses and collected them routinely. The summer of 2010, Raymond and Kayla Herbst, along with their guidance counselor, Daren Patterson, traveled to Wausau to be interviewed by Channel 9 News. They then toured the Ronald McDonald House in Marshfield as well as the PICU at Ministry Saint Joseph’s Children’s Hospital across the street.

Raymond had no idea at the time that in the years to come, he would be a patient there, and his parents would need a place to stay while he recovered. Thanks to Raymond’s efforts, along with each and every person who has donated to the Ronald McDonald House, his parents were able to stay in a clean, warm, and loving home and not have to worry about a thing.

While Raymond was hospitalized, the students at Chequamegon High School held a fundraiser to raise funds for the Ronald McDonald House in Marshfield. Raymond was able to present a check in the amount of \$510.00 that was raised in his name.

This story is truly an example of love and dedication “Coming Full Circle.”

Ronald McDonald House Impact Snapshot

- Accommodation needs are a significant stressor for families of critically ill children, particularly when they are traveling far distances. RMHC and the Ronald McDonald House program help alleviate some of this stress.
- Families attribute their ability to stay together to the Ronald McDonald House program and believe it significantly affects psychological well-being and their child's recovery.
- Caregivers who stay at a Ronald McDonald House report significantly higher levels of involvement in their child's care and more positive hospital experiences.
- Accommodations provided by the Ronald McDonald House program enhance pediatric patients' quality of life.
- Parents who sleep at a Ronald McDonald House enjoy greater sleep quality than those who stay at the pediatric bedside.
- RMHC helps improve family coping and resiliency during pediatric hospitalization.



Children, whose families stay at Ronald McDonald Houses, tend to be the sickest, have traveled the furthest distances for care and spend the longest time in the hospital.
